104 Signal Squadron History Overview

104 Sig Sqn was raised in November 1965 and its first OC was **lan Godden**. Ian attended the reunion in 2011 but sadly passed away a few years back.

In 1967, **104 Sig Sqn** assumed control of Task Force (Brigade) Communications in South Vietnam, completing its tour in late 1971. The unit was then based at Wacol, Ingleburn, Holsworthy.

104 Sig Sqn held their last parade at Holsworthy on 22nd October 1996 before moving to Darwin (Palmerston) and became fully operational again in early 1997.

104 Sig Sqn was absorbed into the **1**st **Command Support Unit** (1CSU), and renamed 'A Sqn' on the 1st January 1998. 1CSU was a combination of 104 Sig Sqn, HQ Coy 1 Bde, 7th Intelligence Company, 72 EW Sqn and 11 MP PI. The unit was formed as a part the Restructuring of the Army trials. When 1CSU became the **1**st **Command Support Regiment**, 104 Sig Sqn was reborn on 18th May 2001 as part of the new Signal Regiment. The 1st Command Support Regiment has since been renamed **1**st **Combat Signal Regiment** (1CSR) but is still based on the original concept however the Intelligence and Military Police capabilities are no longer part of the unit structure.

104 Sig Sqn, 1CSR is located at Robertson Barracks, Palmerston, NT (near Darwin).

Our **memorial rock** with the names of our war dead has been relocated from Holsworthy to Palmerston. See <u>http://www.au104.org/Veteran_Stories/vetstory16.html</u> for details. The Regiment's Battle Communication Wing is called the **"The Signaller Alexander Young Battlefield Communication Wing"** and the boozer is named **"The Abraham Club"** after the two-unit members, KIA in Vietnam. *Lest we forget*.

Since Vietnam, **104 Sig Sqn** has deployed on **Operation Anode** in the Solomon Islands (see <u>http://1csr.au104.org/stories/story-4.html</u>) and on **Operation Slipper** in Afghanistan, as part of the Force Communication Unit 1 (FCU-1). See <u>http://1csr.au104.org/stories/story-7.html</u>. Many of its current members have served in Timor and on other operations.

The current OC, 104 Sig Sqn, **Major Michael Tapscott** is at the reunion and is our guest speaker on Wednesday night. Also the current 104 Sig Sqn SSM **WO2 Brad Wakefield**. Please make both Michael and Brad most welcome.

Certa Cito 100

On 14 February 1925, Australian Army Order (AAO) 71 was issued, stating, "Approval has been given for the Signal Engineer units of the Citizen Forces to be formed into a separate corps and designated the "Australian Corps of Signals". On the 10 November 1948, His Majesty King George VI conferred the title "Royal" on the Australian Corps of Signals.

In 2025, RASigs will recognise its centenary year with a series of events and activities to commemorate and celebrate 100 years of the Royal Australian Corps of Signals, which reflects on our past, present, and future.

Events will be conducted throughout the year by ARA and ARES Signals units across Australia.

The culmination of the Centenary (Certa Cito 100) will occur in November 2025, with major events being planned for South East Queensland, Sydney, Canberra and Melbourne.

The commemorations and celebrations will build esprit de Corps and foster linkages between serving and former serving members and their families (the Australian Signals Community), RA Sigs Associations and industry. The Centenary should also foster and enhance our relationship and linkages to sister Corps and units across the British Army, Canadian Army, New Zealand Army and the United States Army.
